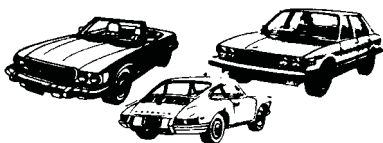

Sadly we had to cancel our spring concert on May 19, because of a lack of participation from other invited choirs. Maybe it will be better next year.

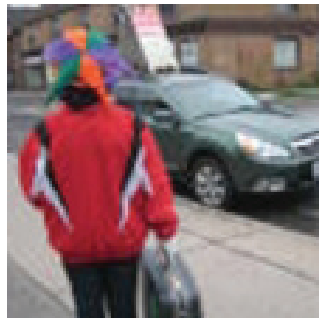

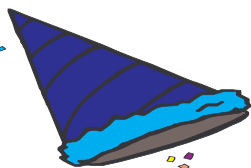
I almost can hear the sabres rattling. Ship ahoy, Matey! Last not least:
